



# Profile: Oregon's Pharmacist Workforce – 2012

## Quick Facts

As in 2010, the majority of Oregon's pharmacists work in retail settings (60%), followed by hospital-based pharmacy settings (26%).

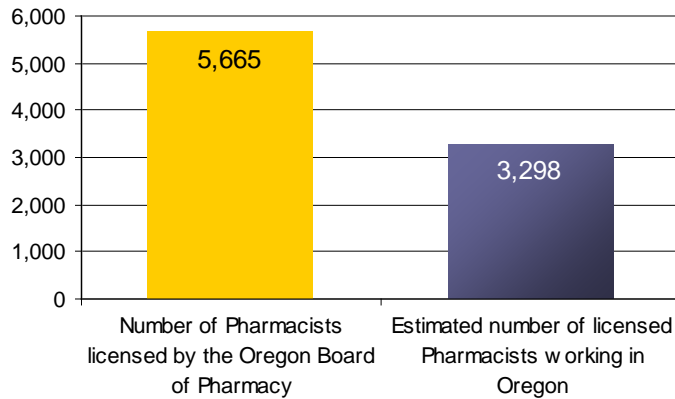
The percentage of pharmacists who reported full-time employment dropped by 2% between 2010 (76%) and 2012 (74%), while part-time employment decreased nearly 4%.

The percentage of females in Oregon's pharmacist workforce dropped slightly from 54% in 2010 to 52% in 2012.

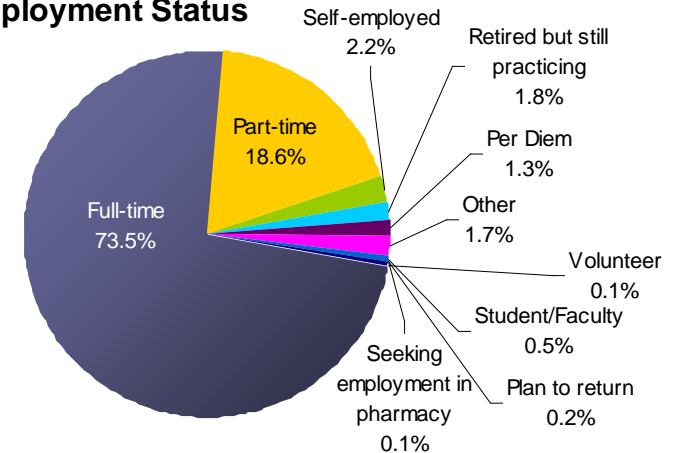
The average age of Oregon's pharmacists is 45 years. The percentage of Oregon's pharmacists 55 years of age and older increased from 27% in 2010 to 30% in 2012.

In 2012, nearly 13% of Oregon's pharmacists reported plans to reduce practice hours, move out of state, leave the practice of pharmacy or retire within the next two years. In 2010, 15% reported similar plans.

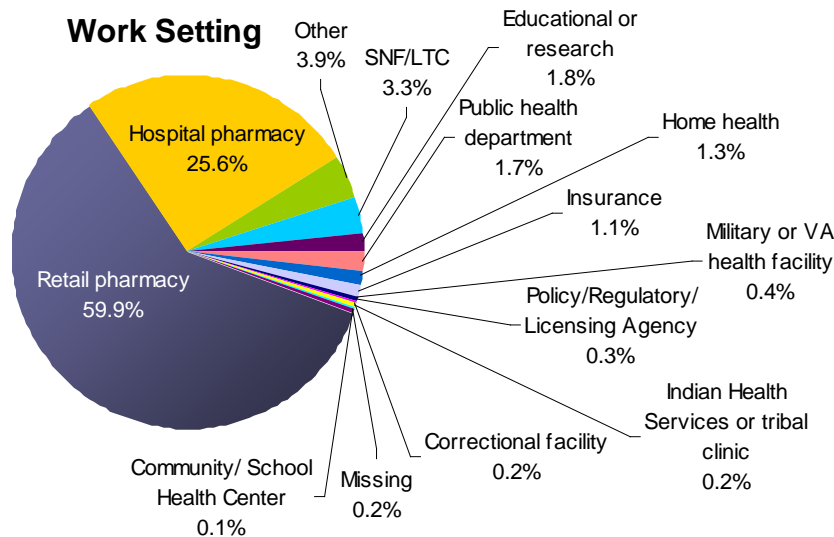
**Number of Pharmacists - 2012**



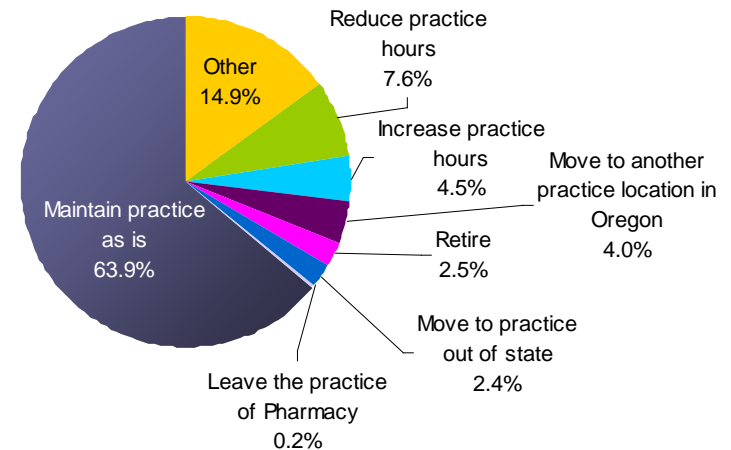
**Employment Status**



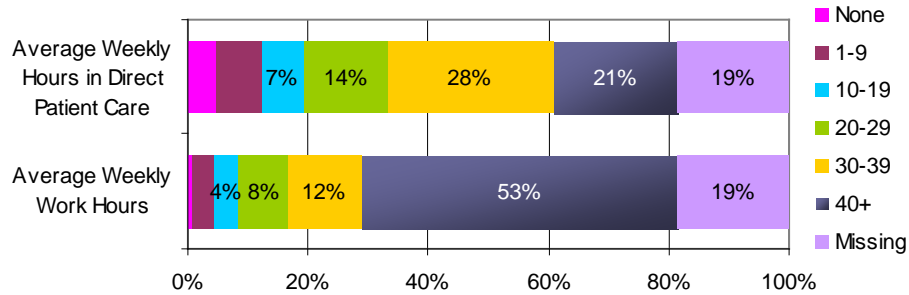
**Work Setting**



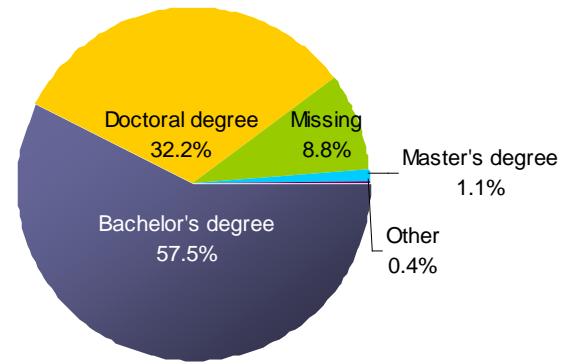
**Future Plans in the Next Two Years**



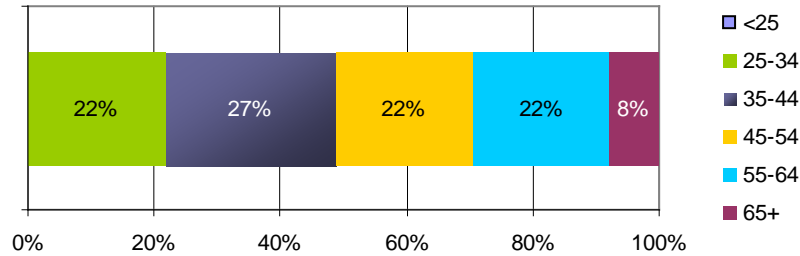
**Average Weekly Work Hours Compared to Average Weekly Hours in Direct Patient Care Activities**



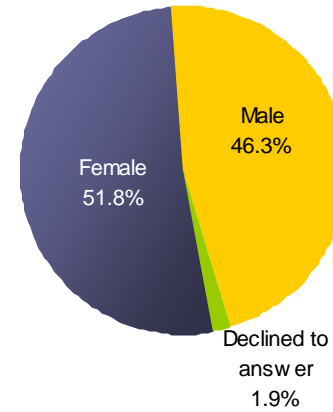
**Pharmacy Degree**



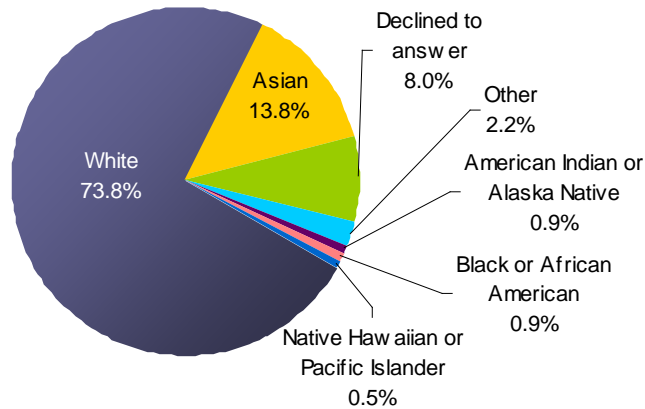
**Age Category**



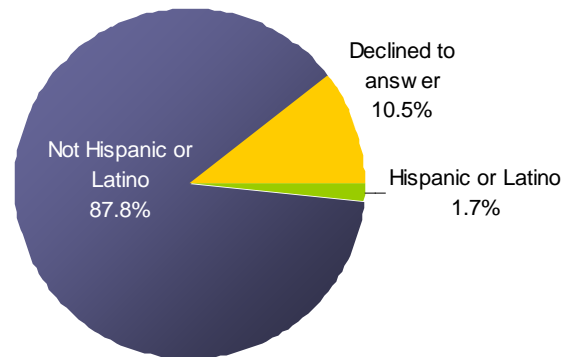
