



Quick Facts

The number of active licensed physical therapists (PTs) who identified a practice location in Oregon increased nearly 11% between 2010 and 2012.

PTs identified a practice address in 34 of Oregon's 36 counties. Twenty-one percent of Oregon's PTs are located in Multnomah County, followed by 15% in Washington County and 11% in Lane County.


As in 2010, the most frequently reported practice specialty in 2012 was orthopedics (51%), followed by geriatrics (29%).


The percentage of PTs 55 years of age and older increased slightly from 21.3% in 2010 to 22% in 2012.

Among PTs, Spanish was the most frequently reported language spoken (9%) in addition to English. In 2010, only 3.5% of Oregon's physical therapists reported speaking Spanish in addition to English.


Profile: Oregon's Physical Therapist Workforce – 2012

Physical Therapists in Oregon: 2010 to 2012






Average Weekly Work Hours Compared with Average Weekly Hours in Direct Patient Care Activities








Future Practice Plans in the Next Two Years
